Information that a Statement of Purpose may contain

Assume that you are an admission committee member. From among hundreds of candidates, you have to admit students. What are the most important factors for you? Academic achievements and good test scores are important. But in an era where the majority of candidates have outstanding academic backgrounds, it becomes increasingly difficult to distinguish between individual applicants and decide who gets the offer of admission. Reasonable objective for studying anticipated major is an important factor which only can be shown in your SOP.

The Statement of Purpose can uncover your uniqueness.

Your SOP should demonstrate your creativity, curiosity, enthusiasm for learning, teamwork ability, and other good attributes. You should "show" these factors in your essay not "talk about" them.

Your Statement of Purpose and application should reflect anything you mention in your essay. For instance, if you talk about your deep desire to follow "X" in your graduate study, your application should show that you have done something about this desire before.

Guidelines for writing Statement of Purpose

Writing your SOP is a long and serious process - several drafts over a two-month period are fairly common. It is necessary to put in this hard work to come up with an essay that is uniquely yourself, and a compelling read which convinces the admissions committee that you are right for their school.

Here is a very brief format of the Statement of Purpose:

Part 1) what would like to study

Part 2) State your accomplishments, honors, and awards.

Part 3) State that you are very excited about the possibility of joining the related program.

Perfecting your Statement of Purpose

So now you have your SOP completed. After correcting it grammatically, you should read it and revise it several times to make it a coherent and unique essay that will award you an offer of admission.

Put your essay away for a while. Then, put yourself in an admissions committee's place and read it in about 30 seconds. Be aware that you are going through a few hundred applications and classifying them into 'accepted,' 'maybe' and 'not accepted' groups. Think of how you would look at SOPs and try to read yours through a stranger's eyes. Use this check-list to be sure that you have mentioned all critical information in your SOP in an honest and interesting manner. - An attention grabbing introduction
- Areas in which you are interested
- The reasons of your interest to those areas
- How these interests relate to your anticipated future career
- How you think further studies will help you
- Additional experiences that may help

Your essay should flow smoothly. You should go through paragraphs coherently. The Statement of Purpose should be grammatically correct and end well to leave the officer with a sense of completion.
